CCVE Checklist for Diplomate

The CCVE(D) classification recognizes senior practitioners at the highest level of professionalism within the field of VE who have made significant contributions through education, professional development & professional contribution activities. Registrants who have received the CCVE(F) credential may be eligible to ladder to **Diplomate** status. Candidates will be required to demonstrate achievements in the areas of accomplishment listed for the CCVE(F) but a higher number of activities in the field are required to attain the CCVE(D) status.

A CCVE(F) demonstrates expertise through several educational, professional development & professional contribution activities. These include professional presentations, contribution to peer-reviewed journals, curriculum/course development, teaching, expertise in the methodology of a TSA, mentoring &/or contributing to the ongoing development of the CCVE examination. Registrants who hold the CCVE in good standing & meet the criteria are eligible for credential laddering to **Fellow** status.
