ICVE Checklist for Diplomate

The **ICVE(D)** classification recognizes senior practitioners at the highest level of professionalism within the field of VE who have made significant contributions through education, professional development & professional contribution activities. Registrants who have received the ICVE(F) credential may be eligible to ladder to **Diplomate** status. Candidates will be required to demonstrate achievements in the areas of accomplishment listed for the ICVE(F) but a higher number of activities in the field are required to attain the ICVE(D) status.

The **ICVE(F)** classification has been developed to recognize individuals within the field who have achieved higher levels of professionalism through post graduate study &/or maintenance of other recognized related professional credentials. An ICVE(F) demonstrates expertise through several educational, professional development & professional contribution activities. These include professional presentations, contributions to peer-reviewed journals, curriculum/course development, teaching, expertise in the methodology of a VE, mentoring &/or contributing to the ongoing development of the ICVE examination. Registrants who hold the ICVE in good standing & meet the criteria are eligible for credential laddering to **Fellow** status.
